In my current role as the head of didactic at Pingu's English I am responsible for overseeing the formation of the groups in accordance to level and controlling all material given out and ordered. I am also teaching courses to ages 3-11 years old using the Pingu material and Cambridge starters and movers.

October 2018- July 2019 E.F.L teacher, Language Team, Ravenna Italy

During my time at Language team, I had experiences working in several different public schools.

- I worked in the scientific high school for 180 hours in classes ranging from the 1st to 5th year.
I also taught projects in different middles schools:
- In San Pier Damiano School, I taught 20 hours in classes from first to 3rd year. I was also responsible for teaching the KET course of 24 hours.
- In San Pietro in Vincoli I taught 20 hours in the middle school from 1st to 3rd year. I was also one of the native speakers for the summer camp / PON projects in 2018 and 2019.
- In the San Biagio institute, I taught 32 hours in Don Minzoni and 32 hours in Torre. I was also one of the experts for the PON project in both schools in summer 2019; I did one week in each school (25 hours in Don Minzoni and 35 hours in Torre)
- I also taught in Morigia School for Architecture and Graphics. In this school, I taught from the first to the fifth classes. I also taught a group of students for the PET certification for 30 hours.

Aside from this, I taught group lessons every afternoon with children from 7-13 years old and one to one lessons with adults for practical and business English.

January 2016- September 2018 EDUCO E.F.L tutor (Bologna, Emilia-Romagna)

In my role as a tutor within EDUCO, I worked as an EFL teacher teaching English through Drama, Theatre and Play. On a day-to-day basis, my role included: co-ordinating and facilitating English and drama workshops and projects based on CLIL to many different students in schools (Primary through to High school) through songs and games and drama-based activities. I was also involved in longer assignments for project-based learning again in all levels of the public school system. I also taught courses and workshops to primary school teachers using these same methods to help them improve their own classroom and English skills.

January 2016 – September 2018 – 'Learning the Language' E.F.L private school

I was also working for a private language school in Bologna, Italy, teaching English lessons, both on an individual basis and in groups to children and adults. The courses I taught ranged in level, starting from absolute beginner through to advanced learners and included grammar focus as well as conversation classes.

September 2015- January 2016 – Playworker – Moorings Way Infant School

In this role I worked in the before and after school club. The children that attended the club were between 4 and 11 years old. The main tasks included organising and supervising the children with crafts, sports, cooking, games and other activities. It also included providing a meal for them and collecting them from 3 different schools via a walking bus service.

Summer 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018,2019– EDUCO- Summer Camp Tutor- I worked for three summers in an English camp setting throughout Italy. In my tutor position, I was teaching English to Italian children aged 5-13. Activities included speaking and listening games and songs, planning and organising language focus for all, as well as producing a final show for the parents. From this I gained an Introduction to TEFL Through Theatre and Play certificate.

Summer 2014 & 2015 - British Learning Academy- Tutor/ Activities Leader

In this role I worked both in a teaching position and as an activity leader simultaneously for 2 summers. I was working with Italian students aged 14-16 who were learning both English and entrepreneurial skills. My tasks included conducting English lessons around t-shirt design, printing and selling for the entrepreneurial side. I also had a role in organising evening and weekend activities and trips that were both beneficial for the students English and enjoyable for them. These included trips to London, Brighton and the local areas around the college and evening activities such as talent shows and quiz nights.
